## GUANTANAMO DETAINEE FILE REVIEW

Mohammed Abdul Malik Bajabu (KE-10025) was inspired by a radical imam to leave Kenya in 1996 to receive extremist training in Somalia, where he developed a close relationship with members of the now defunct al-Qa'ida in East Africa (AQEA), to include senior operational planners. Bajabu became an AQEA facilitator and was closely involved in the preparation and execution of the November 2002 attacks against the Paradise Hotel and an Israeli airliner in Mombasa, Kenya, for which he was arrested in February 2007. Since his last assessment, Bajabu has remained highly compliant at Guantanamo, according to Joint Task Force–Guantanamo (JTF-GTMO). He continues to provide minimal insight into his current mind-set and postdetention plans, although we judge that he is interested in reuniting with his wife and children after transfer.
