Muhammad Rahim (AF-10029) served as a translator, courier, facilitator, and operative for al-Qa'ida's senior leadership, including Usama Bin Ladin. He had advance knowledge of many of al-Qa'ida's attacks, including the 11 September 2001 attacks, and progressed to financing, planning, and participating in Taliban, al-Qa'ida, and other anti-Coalition group attacks in Afghanistan against US and Coalition targets. Rahim has previously expressed a desire to conduct extremist activity and remains generally supportive of extremism. We have no information, however, indicating his interest in personally conducting extremist activity if released. Rahim has been generally compliant since his arrival at Guantanamo and highly compliant since his last disciplinary infraction in June 2015. He has expressed little interest in being repatriated to Afghanistan or transferred to Pakistan and prefers to go to the Middle East should he be released. A review of available reporting has not revealed contact between Rahim and known terrorists outside Guantanamo.
