Hassan Muhammad Salih bin Attash (SA-1456) was a close associate of senior terrorist leaders and was a facilitator and explosives specialist for al-Qa'ida during the early 2000s in Pakistan. He supported plots against US and other Western targets in Afghanistan, Pakistan, the Middle East, and North Africa, and he contributed to al-Qa'ida's explosives activities and capabilities. Attash was arrested in a Pakistani military raid on an al-Qa'ida safehouse with senior al-Qa'ida operative and 9/11 operational coordinator Ramzi bin al-Shibh (YM-10013) in September 2002.
