Sharqawi Abdu Ali al-Hajj (YM-1457), a.k.a. Riyadh the Facilitator, is a career jihadist who was closely tied to several senior al-Qa'ida members, including Usama Bin Ladin and Khalid Shaykh Muhammad (KU-10024), and who acted as a prominent financial and travel facilitator for al-Qa'ida operations, although he may not have had foreknowledge of the plots. He facilitated the movement of fighters from Yemen to Afghanistan before 9/11, operated a guesthouse in Karachi, and funneled Saudi donations to al-Qa'ida once coalition operations began, according to military reporting.
