## GUANTANAMO DETAINEE FILE REVIEW

Abdul Rahim Ghulam Rabbani (PK-1460) was an al-Qa'ida facilitator who worked directly for al-Qa'ida external operations chief Khalid Shaykh Muhammad (KU-10024), primarily focusing on logistic support and running an al-Qa'ida safehouse in Karachi, Pakistan. Recruited by his younger brother and fellow Guantanamo detainee Ahmed Ghulam Rabbani (PK-1461), Abdul Rabbani probably played a support role in al-Qa'ida operations, although we judge that he probably did not have specific insights into al-Qa'ida's operational plans. Since October 2016, he has remained mostly compliant with the guard force at Guantanamo and has not made any anti-American statements, but we continue to have little insight into his mind-set. Rabbani probably retains his previously expressed desire to reunite with his wife and live in a Middle Eastern Arab country. We assess that Rabbani's younger brother may still influence his thinking; the younger Rabbani has been noncompliant during his time at Guantanamo.
