Mohammed Ahmed Ghulam Rabbani (PK-1461), a.k.a. Abu Badr, was a financial and travel facilitator for al-Qa'ida leaders Khalid Shaykh Muhammad (KU-10024) and USS Cole mastermind 'Abd al-Rahim al-Nashiri from 1997 until his arrest in September 2002 during a raid of guest houses that Abu Badr was operating with his brother Abdul Rabbani (PK-1460) in Karachi, Pakistan. Abu Badr's primary jobs were to run al-Qa'ida safehouses in Karachi, Pakistan, facilitate the travel of mujahidin and their families to and from Afghanistan, and acquire and drive vehicles. Abu Badr lived in Saudi Arabia until his early 20s but spent his active jihadist years in Pakistan.
