The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee does not remain necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board acknowledges the detainee's past terrorist-related activities and connections but determined the detainee's threat can be adequately mitigated by Saudi Arabia. The Board has confidence in the efficacy of the Saudi rehabilitation program and Saudi Arabia's ability to monitor the detainee after completion of the program and found the detainee credible on his desire to participate in the program. The Board noted the detainee's strong desire to engage in scholarly religious discussion and receive guidance from the clerics at the rehabilitation center about Islam and his willingness to submit to the authority of the Saudi government. The detainee was candid with the Board, including regarding his presence on the battlefield and world view, and articulated a commitment to fulfilling his role within his family over taking up arms or continuing to engage in jihad.

The PRB recommends that the detainee be transferred to Saudi Arabia with appropriate security assurances, as determined by the Guantanamo Detainee Transfer Working Group, for participation in the local counseling and care program.
