DETAINEE BACKGROUND

Haroon al-Afghani (AF-3148) was a Hezb-e Islami Gulbuddin (HIG) commander who organized and led attacks on coalition forces in Afghanistan and served as an intermediary between senior al-Qa'ida members and other anticoalition fighters.

SUMMARY OF DETENTION

Since our last review in April 2017, Afghani remained semicompliant. He has committed a moderate number of disciplinary infractions relative to other detainees. Afghani will probably remain semicompliant in the near term.

• In April 2017, Afghani was seen by medical staff at Guantanamo and was rude to a female member of the medical staff, telling her that he would not talk to her and that she is a bad person, according to US military reporting.

We assess that Afghani maintains an extremist mindset, though he generally says very little that would raise alarm.
