

**Unclassified Summary of Final Determination**

The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States. The Board recognizes the detainee presents some level of threat in light of his past activities, skills, and associations; however, the Board found that in light of the factors and conditions of transfer identified below, the threat the detainee presents can be adequately mitigated.

In making this determination, the Board considered that the detainee's business connections and associations with al-Qa'ida and the Taliban pre-date 9/11 and appear to have ended. The Board also noted that the detainee does not appear to be motivated by extremist ideologies, and the detainee's relatively compliant behavior and cooperative attitude toward JTF-GTMO staff.

The Board recommends that the detainee be transferred with the appropriate security assurances, as negotiated by the Special Envoys and agreed to by relevant USG departments and agencies, preferably to a country with reintegration support and the capacity to implement robust security measures, including monitoring and travel restrictions.
