# GUANTANAMO DETAINEE FILE REVIEW

Suhayl Abdul Anam al-Sharabi (YM-569) trained in Afghanistan before 9/11, became a bodyguard for Usama Bin Ladin, and may have been associated with an aborted 9/11 style hijacking plot in Southeast Asia led by al-Qa'ida external operations chief Khalid Shaykh Muhammad (KU-10024). Sharabi was highly noncompliant with detention staff until he ended his long-term, nonreligious fast in November 2014 and has had no infractions since September 2015. He has no known ongoing terrorism connections and maintains only intermittent contact with his family in Taiz, Yemen, none of whom appear to be involved in terrorist activity.
