The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board noted the detainee's sustained record of compliance since late 2009 and found no clear indication the detainee harbors strong anti-American sentiments or supports violent extremism. Further, the board considered the detainee's efforts to pursue educational opportunities while in detention and his credible desire to start a new life, including the acceptance of the fact that the most stable environment may be a third country. The Board also noted the ability and willingness of the detainee's family and others to support him in the event of transfer and the absence of indications that the detainee or his family members have ties to terrorists outside of Guantanamo, including former detainees.

The PRB recommends the detainee be transferred with appropriate security assurances, as determined by the Guantanamo Detainee Transfer Working Group, preferably to an Arabic-speaking country with access to integration assistance.
