Unclassified Summary of Final Determination

The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States. The Board has some concern with the detainee's failure to demonstrate sufficient candor related to events prior to detention, but in light of the factors and conditions of transfer identified below, the Board finds the risk the detainee presents can be adequately mitigated.

In making this determination, the Board considered that the detainee did not express any intent to reengage in terrorist activities nor has he espoused any anti-US sentiment that would indicate he views the US as his enemy. The Board also noted the detainee's degree of involvement and significance in extremist activities appears to be that of a low-level fighter, the detainee's record of compliance while at Guantanamo and history of positive engagements with the guard force, and multiple letters of support, to include willingness to provide the detainee with financial and integration support upon transfer.

The Board recommends transfer, with the appropriate security assurances as negotiated by the Special Envoys and agreed to by relevant USG departments and agencies.
