The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered the detainee's degree of involvement and significance in extremist activities has been reassessed to be that of a low-level fighter. Although the detainee admitted to fighting with the Taliban, he explained his rationale for doing so and articulated his regret. The Board noted the availability of familial and financial resources and structures within the region and the detainee's progression over the past few years to be more open to other cultures. Finally, the detainee has no known close associations with terrorists outside of Guantanamo.

The Board recommends transfer only to an Arabic-speaking country, preferably a GCC country, with the appropriate security assurances as negotiated by the Special Envoys and agreed to by relevant USG departments and agencies.
