Hani Saleh Rashid Abdullah (YM-841) traveled to fight in Afghanistan in June 2001, trained at al-Qa'ida's al-Farouq camp, and admitted to a close association with al-Qa'ida's external operations planners and senior leadership. He was assessed to be one of six Yemeni fighters—the so-called Karachi Six—who were directed by al-Qa'ida external operations chief Khalid Shaykh Muhammad (KU-10024) to conduct operations against US forces and American citizens frequenting hotels in Karachi, Pakistan. He was arrested when Pakistani authorities raided three safehouses associated with the plotting in Karachi in September 2002.
