

**Unclassified Summary of Final Determination**

The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee remains necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered that it was unable to determine whether the detainee has had a change in his extremist mindset due to his terse and vague responses to questions from Board members, his lack of candor regarding his activities and affiliation with al-Qa'ida, his continued and recent extremist statements, and a lack of delineation from his past extremist views and his present views. The Board also noted the detainee's high level of significant noncompliance while in detention prior to July 2015, including serious offenses against the guard force, and his refusal to acknowledge those offenses. Finally, the Board considered the detainee's susceptibility to recruitment due to his attitude and his post-detention plan's reliance on total support from his family or the receiving country.

The Board appreciates the detainee's effort to spend time in detention constructively, specifically, exploring his skills in model building and ending his hunger strike, as well as his engagement with his family on future plans. The Board encourages the detainee to be compliant and provide more candid, thoughtful engagement in future reviews.
