The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered the detainee's low level of training and lack of a leadership position in al Qaeda or the Taliban, the detainee's highly compliant behavior at Guantanamo for over the past six years, the detainee's willingness to participate in a rehabilitation program, the family support available to the detainee, the detainee's consistent engagement with the PRB process and willingness to respond to questions from the Board and the detainee's extensive and continuing efforts to take advantage of educational opportunities while at Guantanamo to improve his ability to support himself upon transfer

The PRB recommends the following conditions that relate to the detainee's transfer: Appropriate security assurances as negotiated by and agreed to by relevant USG departments and agencies.
