The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States. The Board found that, in light of the factors and conditions of the transfer identified below, the threat which the detainee presents can be adequately mitigated.

In making this determination, the Board considered that the detainee demonstrated candor and provided details of his pre-detention activities and mindset, the detainee's efforts to take advantage of opportunities in detention to better himself, including academic, art, and business classes. The Board also noted the detainee does not appear to be driven to reengage by extremist ideology, has not made statements against the U.S. or Western allies, and that the detainee has been mostly compliant in detention. Finally, the Board considered the support network available to the detainee upon transfer, from family and others, and that the detainee has no known familial ties to extremism.

The Board recommends resettlement to a GCC country with a strong rehabilitation and reintegration program and access to familial support, with the appropriate security assurances as negotiated by the Special Envoys and agreed to by relevant USG departments and agencies.
