**DECISION:** The Periodic Review Board (PRB) determines:

By consensus, continued law of war detention of the detainee *remains necessary* to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

By consensus, continued law of war detention *is no longer necessary* to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

**FACTORS WHICH CONTRIBUTED TO THE CONSENSUS DETERMINATION** (*attach additional sheets if needed*)

- Past involvement in terrorist activities, to include almost certainly having been selected by senior al-Qaeda members to be the 20<sup>th</sup> hijacker for the 9/11 attacks and after failing in that effort, returning to Afghanistan and fighting on the front lines against the Northern Alliance.

- The Board's inability to assess the detainee's current mindset [REDACTED] due to his continued refusal to respond to questions from the Board regarding his reasons for traveling to Afghanistan and ensuing activities. The lack of information prevented the Board from understanding how and to what extent his psychiatric condition contributed to his decisions during that time.

- The Board recommends the detainee continue to engage with the treating Guantanamo Bay mental health officials. The Board commends the detainee's recognition of his mental health diagnoses, looks forward to reviewing the detainee's file in six months, and encourages the detainee to be more forthcoming with the Board in future reviews and to cooperate with mental health officials.

The PRB recommends the following conditions that relate to the detainee's transfer
