## GUANTANAMO DETAINEE FILE REVIEW

Mustafa Faraj Muhammad Muhammad Mas'ud al-Jadid al-'Uzaybi, a.k.a. Abu Faraj al-Libi (LY-10017), traveled to Afghanistan to fight at a young age, joined al-Qa'ida, and rose through al-Qa'ida's hierarchy to become the group's general manager and a trusted adviser for and communications conduit to Usama Bin Ladin and deputy amir Ayman al-Zawahiri. He has been semi-compliant, and we assess he remains committed to al-Qa'ida's global jihadist ideology. While we have no indication that Abu Faraj has had contact with terrorist personalities since his detention, members of his family have varying levels of involvement in terrorist activities.
