The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee remains necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered the detainee's lengthy history as a jihadist, working as a facilitator, attending al-Qa'ida training, and engaging in extremist support in Afghanistan and Southeast Asia, as well as the detainee's significant role in major terrorist attacks and plotting. The Board noted that the detainee was not willing to accept any responsibility nor demonstrate any remorse for any of the activities or operations to which he has been connected, and the lack of supporting evidence of a change in mindset; in fact, the Board noted that the detainee's claimed change of mindset is contradicted by other reporting. Lastly, the Board considered the detainee's testimony to be elusive and non-credible, including half-truths and clear attempts to minimize and conceal his pre-detention activities.
