This periodic review board is being conducted at 0909 hours on 15 October 2019, with regard 5 to the following detainee: Encep Nurjaman Hambali ISN 10019). As a reminder, the unclassified portions of these 6 7 proceedings are being recorded for the purpose of generating 8 a transcript to be posted on the PRS website. Representatives from the following agencies are present and 9 10 are members of the Board: 11 Department of Defense Department of State 12 13 Department of Justice 14 Department of Homeland Security 15 Office of the Director of National Intelligence 16 and Office of the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. The 17 following personnel are also present: 18 Legal Advisor to the Board 19 Case Administrators 20 Personal Representatives 21 and the Security Officer The detainee's Personal Representative, is located at the 22 detention facility, U.S. Naval Station Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. 23 24 He is attending via video teleconference. The detainee has 25 chosen not to attend. This session is being observed by 26 foreign, national and local media; Foreign Government 27 Officials and Representatives from Non-Governmental 28 Organizations. PM: This board is convened to determine whether continued law of 29 30 war detention is warranted for Encep Nurjaman Hambali (ISN 31 10019) to protect against the continuing significant threat 32 to the security of the United States. This session of the

hearing is unclassified. Personal Representative has the 33 34 detainee had a chance to review the unclassified Summary? PR: Yes, Sir. 35 36 PM: Thank you. I will now read the unclassified Summary. Encep 37 Nurjaman, a.k.a Hambali (ISN 10019) was an operational 38 mastermind in the Southeast Asia-based extremist group Jemaah Islamiyah (JI) and served as the main interface between JI 39 40 and al Qa'ida from 2000 until his capture in mid-2003. Reputed in regional media as "the Usama bin Ladin of 41 42 Southeast Asia," he trained and fought in Afghanistan in the mid-1980s, and subsequently participated in violent jihad 43 throughout Southeast Asia, including his lead role in 44 planning the 2002 bombing in Bali, Indonesia. Since arriving 45 46 in Guantanamo in 2006, Hambali has positioned himself as a 47 mentor to other High-Value Detainees (HVDs) and a hub for news regarding their cases, even as he has grown pessimistic 48 49 about his own prospects for release. He remains very close to his JI lieutenant Mohammed Basihr Bin Lap, a.k.a. Lillie 50 (ISN 10022) who was captured with Hambali, and with whom 51 52 Hambali shares cultural bonds. Does the Personal Representative wish to make an unclassified opening statement 53 54 at this time? PR: Yes. Sir. 55 PM: I would like to remind all participants that any information 56 shared at this time must be unclassified. If there is a 57 concern about the classification of the information, I will 58 59 indicate as such and will stop the proceedings until we resolve this issue. Has the detainee had the opportunity to 60 61 review your statement? 62 PR: Yes. Sir.

PM: Okay, Personal Representative, please proceed.

On advice from his Personal Counsel, Hambali is not 66 going to participate in today's hearing. Hambali continues 67 68 to refuse every meetings made with him since his last hearing in April of 2019. Meetings were scheduled with Hamibali in 69 70 June 2019. And meetings that were scheduled in August and September were cancelled due to operational limitations. I 71 72 will continue to schedule meetings and afford Hambali a 73 chance to meet in order to present information for his 74 upcoming PRB hearings. Therefore, were have no new 75 information to present to the Board at this time. PM: Board Members may reserve questions until detainee and 76 77 witness statements have been presented in their entirety. 78 Does anyone have a question at this particular time? PM: Okay, with no questions, this concluded this portion of the 79 80 hearing. I ask that all remain seated until further instructed by the Case Administrator. 81 82 CA: Inaudible.
