2 commence momentarily. Please be advised that the audio and
3 video feed is now active. This periodic review board is
4 being conducted at 0908 hours on 25 June 2019, with regard to
5 the following detainee: Bashir bin Lap (ba-Sheer Bin-Laap)
6 (ISN 10022). As a reminder, the unclassified portions of
7 these proceedings are being recorded for the purpose of
8 generating a transcript to be posted on the PRS website.

24 The detainee's Personal Representative is located at the
25 detention facility, U.S. Naval Station Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.
26 He is attending via video teleconference. The detainee
27 waived translation of the unclassified summary and the
28 personnel, correction Personal Representative's opening
29 statement. These documents are been posted in the Periodic
30 Review Secretariat website. This session is being observed
31 by foreign, national and local media; Foreign Government

32 Officials and Representatives from Non-Governmental

34 PM: This board is convened to determine whether continued law of
35 war detention is warranted for Bashir bin Lap (ba-Sheer Bin-
36 Laap) (ISN 10022) to protect against the continuing
37 significant threat to the security of the United States. This
38 session of the hearing is unclassified. Representative has
39 the detainee have the opportunity to review the unclassified
40 summary?

41 PR: Yes, Sir.

42 PM: Thank you. I will now read the UNCLASSIFIED SUMMARY.
43 Mohammand Bashir Bin Lap, a.k.a Lillie (ISN 10022) - a Jemaah
44 Islamiyah (JI) associate and al-Qa'ida member prior to his
45 detention - is one of two remaining Malaysian detainees at
46 Guantanamo Bay. He became interested in extremism as a
47 young; as a youth, traveled to Afghanistan in mid-2000, and
48 was a key lieutenant for fellow high value detainee, and
49 senior al-Qa'ida and Riduan Bin Isomuddin a.k.a Hambali his
50 ID number is 10019. Does the Personal Representative wish to
51 make an unclassified opening statement at this time?

52 PR: Yes, Sir.

53 PM: I would like to remind all participants that any information
54 shared at this time must be unclassified. If there is a
55 concern about the classification of the information, I will
56 indicate as such and will stop the proceedings until we
57 resolve the issue. Has the detainee had the opportunity to
58 review your statement?

59 PR: Yes, Sir.

60 PM: Thank you, the Personal Representative, please proceed.

61 PR: Members of the Board, thank you for the opportunity to
62 present this Full Review for Mohammed Bashir bin Lap (ISN
63 10022). Bashir continues to refuse all meetings scheduled

64 with him since I was assigned as his Personal Representative.
65 Since his previous file review in January, 2019 meetings were
66 scheduled with Bashir on January 18th, March 15th, and May
67 17th. He refused to meet on all those occasions. I will
68 continue to schedule meetings and afford Bashir a chance to
69 meet in order to present information for his future PRB
70 hearings. Therefore, we have no new information to present
71 to the Board at this time.

72 PM: Okay, Board Members may reserve questions until detainee and
73 witness statements have been presented in their entirety.

74 Does anyone have a question at this particular time?

75 PM: With no questions, this concluded this portion of the
76 hearing. I ask that all remain seated until further
77 instructed by the Case Administrator.

78 CA: We will take a recess to prepare for the remaining sessions.
