**Unclassified Summary of Final Determination**

The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee remains necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered the detainee's long history with al-Qa'ida as well as providing logistical and operational support to al-Qa'ida in East Africa (AQEA) leaders, including casing Camp Lemonier in Djibouti, the target of an AQEA plot. Additionally, the Board noted that the detainee minimized his role in assisting AQEA, the lack of specificity and credibility in the detainee's responses to questions regarding a change in mindset, and the detainee's lack of candor regarding periods of noncompliant behavior and anti-US statements while in detention.

The Board recognizes the detainee's large family and its ability to support him as well as his presentation of reasonable thoughts on a plan for supporting himself. The Board looks forward to reviewing the detainee's file in six months and encourages him to be more candid about his past and current mindset.
