## GUANTANAMO DETAINEE FILE REVIEW

Hasan Ahmed Guleed (SO-10023) traveled in 1995 from Sweden to Afghanistan for jihadist purposes; trained at probable al-Qa'ida sites; and returned in 1996 to Somalia, where he joined the radical Muslim group Al-Ittihad al-Islami (AIAI), fought against the Ethiopian military, and provided training to AIAI members. Guleed later served as a key member of al-Qa'ida in East Africa's (AQEA) network in Somalia, providing logistical and operational support to AQEA leaders, including probably casing Djibouti's Camp Lemonier, the target of an AQEA plot. Since March 2016, Guleed has been compliant in detention and has not expressed support for violent extremism or indicated he plans to reengage in terrorist activities; however, we assess that he has intentionally censored himself to increase his odds of transfer from Guantanamo. We have not identified any direct contact between Guleed and extremists outside Guantanamo, and we have no information that his family members have engaged in extremist activities.
