The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee remains necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered the detainee's past involvement in terrorist activities including a close relationship with high-level operational planners and members of Al Qaida in East Africa and his participation in the preparation and execution of the November 2002 attacks in Mombasa, Kenya. The Board's inability to assess the detainee's current mindset and level of threat due to the detainee's refusal to meet with his personal representative, the lack of submission of any new materials and the detainee's decision not to attend the hearing.
