The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee remains necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered that the detainee was a trusted member of Al Qaeda who worked directly for senior members of Al Qaeda, including Usama bin Laden, serving as a translator, courier, facilitator, and operative. The detainee had advanced knowledge of many Al Qaeda attacks, to include 9/11, and progressed to paying for, planning, and participation in attacks in Afghanistan against U.S. and Coalition targets.

The Board considered the detainee's extensive extremist connections that provide a path to re-engagement, the detainee's refusal to answer the Board's questions regarding his past activities and past extremist statements, and the detainee's failure to explain any change in his mindset or level of threat.
