The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee remains necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the national security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered that the detainee was a trusted member of Al Qaeda who worked directly for senior members of Al Qaeda, including Usama bin Laden, serving as a translator, courier, facilitator, and operative. The detainee had advanced knowledge of many Al Qaeda attacks, to include 9/11, and progressed to financing, planning, and participation in attacks in Afghanistan against U.S. and Coalition targets.

The Board considered the detainee's extensive extremist connections and consistent and long-standing expressions of support for extremism that provide a path to re-engagement, and the detainee's continued non-compliant behavior and anti-American expressions in detention. The detainee's unwillingness to discuss pre-detention activities and beliefs prevented the Board from assessing whether he has had any change in mindset or level of threat.
