The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered the detainee's low level of involvement with extremists prior to detention, there is no information indicating that the detainee engaged in activities against the United States prior to detention, the support available to the detainee should he be transferred from his family, counsel, and the Life After Guantanamo Project. The Board is cognizant of an increase in incidents of non-compliance over the past couple of years but evidence suggests that is a result of stress and his deteriorating mental health.

The PRB recommends the following conditions that relate to the detainee's transfer: Appropriate security assurances as negotiated by and agreed to by relevant USG departments and agencies.
