The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee remains necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered the detainee's past involvement in terrorist activities, including contacts and activities with Usama Bin Laden, Kahlid Shakyh Muhammad and other senior al-Qa'ida members, facilitating financial transactions and travel, and developing media for al-Qa'ida. The Board also considered the detainee's continued refusal to take responsibility for his involvement with al-Qa'ida. The Board noted its inability to assess the detainee's mindset due to his complete lack of candor, and the significant inconsistencies between written submissions to the Board and the detainee's testimony concerning family support and future plans. Finally, the Board considered the detainee's indifference to the impact of his prior actions and the lack of evidence of significant mitigation measures.
