DECISION: The Periodic Review Board (PRB) determines:

By consensus, continued law of war detention of the detainee *remains necessary* to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

By consensus, continued law of war detention *is no longer necessary* to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

FACTORS WHICH CONTRIBUTED TO THE CONSENSUS DETERMINATION (*attach additional sheets if needed*)

- The detainee's past involvement in terrorist activities including contacts and activities with Usama Bin Laden, Khalid Shaykh Muhammad, and other senior Al Qaeda members, facilitating financial transactions and travel, and developing media for Al Qaeda.
- The detainee's statements regarding his mindset and potential for reengagement are not credible in light of his continued minimization of his interactions with Al Qaeda, the change in justification for engaging with Al Qaeda, failure to exhibit any remorse for the actions he does acknowledge, and dishonesty in his responses to Board questions.
- Recent changes in his family and financial situation show a lack of available support should he be transferred.

The PRB recommends the following conditions that relate to the detainee's transfer: NA
