The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee does not remain necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board noted the low threat level presented by the detainee in light of his lack of advanced training and any significant leadership role with the Taliban. The Board also considered the detainee's increased cooperation with the PRB process, information regarding the detainee's family support and plans to assist the detainee, that the detainee was generally forthright regarding his associations, and that the detainee expressed a willingness to participate in a rehabilitation program. Finally, the Board noted that both the detainee and his family lack links to extremists outside of Guantanamo, and that the detainee has remained mostly compliant with the guard force at Guantanamo, with his last violent offense occurring in 2013.

The PRB recommends that the detainee be transferred with appropriate security assurances and integration support, as determined by the Guantanamo Detainee Transfer Working Group, preferably to an Arabic speaking country with a rehabilitation program or reintegration program. The Board encourages the detainee to continue regularly attending classes and continue engaging with family members to prepare himself for transfer.
