The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the national security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board recognized the detainee presents some level of threat. However, the Board found the threat can be adequately mitigated.

The board considered the age of the detainee at the time of his involvement with extremists, the ability of the USG to identify a receiving country that will address the risks involved, the detainee's expressed willingness to participate in a rehabilitation program, the support available to the detainee if transferred, and the detainee's positive influence within the camps. Finally, the Board considered that the detainee was more candid with the Board in response to questions in comparison to the last hearing he attended.

The PRB recommends the following conditions that relate to the detainee's transfer: Transfer to a country with a strong rehabilitation and reintegration program which includes enhanced monitoring.
