**Unclassified Summary of Final Determination**

The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee remains necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered the detainee's lengthy and continuous association with al-Qa'ida, beginning with training in Afghanistan in 1994. The Board also noted that the detainee was a financial and travel facilitator over an extended period of time for al-Qa'ida external operations chief Khaled Shaykh Muhammad and USS Cole bombing mastermind Abd al-Rahim al-Nashiri. Furthermore, the Board considered the detainee's lack of candor, his evasive and non-responsive answers to the Board's questions, and his multiple contradictory statements which made it difficult for the Board to assess his mindset. Finally, the Board noted the detainee's refusal to take responsibility or appreciate the implications of his pre-detention activities, the detainee's lengthy history of highly non-compliant behavior during detention, the detainee's strong expressions of support for terrorist activities, and the lack of evidence of a change in the detainee's mindset.
