The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board recognizes the detainee presents some level of threat in light of his past activities and associations; however, the Board found that his threat profile is very similar to that of his brother who has been deemed eligible for transfer and that in light of the other factors and conditions of transfer identified below, the threat the detainee presents can be adequately mitigated. Also, the board considered that the detainee has significant medical issues associated with his physical and mental health and the detainee does not appear to demonstrate an extremist mindset or appear to be driven to reengage by extremist ideology.

The PRB recommends the following conditions that relate to the detainee's transfer: Appropriate security assurances as negotiated by and agreed to by relevant USG departments and agencies.
