The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee remains necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered the detainee's lengthy and continuous association with al Qaida, beginning with training in Afghanistan in 1994. The Board also noted that the detainee was a financial and travel facilitator over an extended period of time for al Qaida external operations chief, Khalid Shaykh Muhammad, and USS Cole bombing mastermind, Abd al-Rahim al-Nashiri.

The Board's inability to assess the detainee's current mindset and level of threat due to his refusal to meet with his personal representative, the lack of submission of any new materials and his decision not to attend the hearing.
