The 27 detainee has waived translation of the unclassified 28 summary, the Personal Representative's statement, and the 29 Private Counsel's statement. DC Translator: [Translates above] 35 This Board is convened to determine whether continued law 36 37 of war detention is warranted for Abd Al-Salam Al-Hilah (ISN 1463) to protect against a continuing significant 38 threat to the security of the United States. From here 39 40 forward, we will refer to the detainee as Abdul Salam. This session of the hearing is unclassified. 41 DC Translator: [Translates above] 42 43 PM: Abdul Salam, this is your Periodic Review Board to determine whether continued law of war detention is 44 45 warranted in your case. Continued law of war detention will be warranted if it is necessary to protect against a 46 continuing significant threat to the national security of 47 the United States. The focus of this hearing is on the 48 threat you may pose to the United States and its interests 49 if transferred or released from U.S. custody. 65	Abd Al-Salam Al-Hilah (ISN 1463) was a prominent extremist
66	facilitator who used his position within the Yemeni
67	Political Security Organization to provide refuge and
68	logistic support to al-Qa'ida and other extremist groups.
69	He had unspecified ties to Usama bin Laden and may have
70	played a role in the attack on the USS Cole in October
71	2000. Al-Hilah was detained in Egypt in September 2002 and
72	transferred to Joint Task force - Guantanamo Bay (JTF-GTMO)
73	in September 2004. Does the Personal Representative wish to
74	make an unclassified Opening Statement at this time?

79	information shared at this time must be unclassified. If

97 Guantanamo Bay. Abdul Salam is cooperative and attends all 98 scheduled meetings. He consistently expresses appreciation for both my assistance and that of his private counsel. 99 100 Prior to his detainment, Abdul Salam was a man who loved 101 God, his family, and his country. He had great ambitions that allowed him to excel as a business man and tribal 102 103 leader while also providing an opportunity to gain the 104 respect of Yemeni political leaders. Today, his only desire is to be reunited with his family and make up for lost 105 106 time. Abdul Salam supports peaceful coexistence and believes that he - that should be reflected in our daily 107 108 interactions with one another, regardless of race, gender, or religion. He does not support acts of violence against 109 innocent people and does not condone terrorism for any 110 reason. He has consistently expressed disdain for Al-Qaeda 111 and does not support the group's ideology. Mutual respect 112 113 is very important for Abdul Salam and his expectation of respect does not make him a criminal or threat to the 114 United States. Indeed, he has demonstrated compassion and 115 caring towards those less fortunate in many of our 116 conversations. Above all else, Abdul Salam maintains that 117 he never had any intentions to harm the United States, its 118 allies, or the people of Western Democracies. In all our 119 meetings, I have never seen an indication that he would be 120 a threat to the United States or its allies. He is eager to 121 answer any questions the Board may have. Thank you for your 122 time and consideration. 123 Thank you. Due to the current uh global health pandemic, 124 PM: 125 the PC has been unable to travel to GTMO and participate in the unclassified portion of this hearing. As a result, the 126 PC's statement will be available for review during the 127 classified session. 128
