

**Unclassified Summary of Final Determination**

The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee does not remain necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board noted the detainee's low level of training and lack of a leadership position in al-Qaeda or the Taliban. The Board considered the detainee's personal commitment to participate fully in the Government of Kuwait's rehabilitation program and comply with any security measures, as well as the detainee's extensive family support. The Board found the detainee's statements to be credible regarding his commitment not to support extremist groups or other groups that promote violence, and noted the positive changes in the detainee's behavior while in detention. The Board also considered information provided by the Government of Kuwait that indicated its confidence in its legal authority to require and maintain the detainee's participation in a rehabilitation program and commitment to implement robust security measures.

The PRB recommends that the detainee be transferred to Kuwait with appropriate security assurances, as determined by the Guantanamo Detainee Transfer Working Group, and the implementation of the robust treatment plan as provided by the Government of Kuwait, including the detainee's participation in a full rehabilitation program for at least one year of in-patient rehabilitation. The Board also recommends implementation of the comprehensive set of security measures as presented to the Board.
