The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined continued law of war detention of the detainee is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered the fact that the detainee was a low level fighter and lacked a leadership position in al-Qa'ida or the Taliban. The Board also considered the detainee's improvement in behavior at Guantanamo over the past four years and the lack of indications that the detainee harbors anti-American sentiments, extremist beliefs, or intentions to reengage. The Board also considered the detainee's willingness to sever ties with family members who harbor extremist beliefs and the detainee's statements regarding his strong desire to return to his family, while also noting the family's willingness and ability to support the detainee in the event of transfer.

The PRB recommends that the detainee be transferred to a third country with appropriate support, subject to appropriate security assurances as determined by the Guantanamo Detainee Transfer Working Group.
