The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention remains necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board acknowledges the detainee's low level of training and lack of leadership in al Qaida or the Taliban; however, the Board remains concerned in light of the following factors: The detainee's susceptibility to reengage due to his inability to manage his emotions and actions, the detainee's high level of significant non-compliance in the past year, and the detainee's lack of plans for the future if transferred.

The Board is aware that the detainee has a full review next scheduled for May of 2022 and the Board encourages the detainee to participate fully in the PRB process to prepare for that hearing, to include meeting with his PR consistently, assisting in preparing materials for the review, and making plans for a productive future if transferred.

The Board also encourages the detainee to immediately work toward showing improved compliance and better management of his emotions. The Board specifically requests a plan from his PR and PC regarding how his mental health conditions will be managed if he were to be transferred.
