**Unclassified Summary of Final Determination**

The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee does not remain necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board noted that the most derogatory prior assessments regarding the detainee's activities before detention have been discredited and the current information shows that the detainee has low level military capability. Further, the detainee has been largely compliant with the guard force during detention and has engaged constructively with other detainees and the guards to resolve issues. During the hearing, the detainee was open with the Board regarding his past activities, identified his past decisions as mistakes, and the Board observed an absence of any evidence of an extremist mindset. The Board also noted the detainee's family's commitment to support the detainee upon transfer and the absence of evidence that the detainee's family members have terrorist connections.

The PRB recommends that the detainee be transferred with appropriate security assurances, as determined by the Guantanamo Detainee Transfer Working Group, preferably to an Arabic-speaking country that will enroll the detainee in an integration program to assist his transition to life outside Guantanamo.
