The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined continued law of war detention of the detainee remains necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered that the detainee almost certainly retains an extremist mindset and had close ties with high-level al-Qaeda leaders in the past. The Board found the detainee credible with respect to his desire to return to his family, which appears willing to help with his reintegration, but also considered the detainee's susceptibility for recruitment due to his connections to extremists and his residual anger at the US. The Board noted a lack of history regarding the efficacy of the rehabilitation program Kuwait will implement for a detainee with his particular mindset, but appreciates the efforts of the Kuwaiti government and encourages the officials at the Al Salam Rehabilitation Center to continue to work with the detainee at Guantanamo. The Board looks forward to reviewing the detainee's file in six months and hopes to see his continued participation in future reviews.
