GUANTANAMO DETAINEE FILE REVIEW

Ghassan Abdallah Ghazi al-Sharbi (SA-682) attended a US flight school in early 2001, where he associated with two 9/11 hijackers. He later helped construct IEDs in Pakistan to attack coalition forces and may have been involved in Homeland attack planning. Despite receiving only a few infractions since our last review, Sharbi has continued to engage in a long-term, nonreligious fast. He has also been hostile with the guard force throughout his detention and has previously made statements that suggest he retains extremist views. We have since seen no indication that Sharbi has abandoned his extremist leanings; in August 2016 we assessed that Sharbi probably retained terrorist aspirations based on statements in support of ISIS and al-Qa'ida, as well as his behavior toward the detention staff.
