The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered the detainee's lack of a leadership or facilitator position in al-Qaeda or the Taliban, the efficacy of rehabilitation programs and measures they can take to mitigate any future threat, the detainee's improved record of compliance in detention, the detainee's engagement in the PRB process to include attending all meetings set by the Personal Representative and the detainee's engagement with medical staff to improve his physical and mental health issues.

The PRB recommends the following conditions that relate to the detainee's transfer: Implementation of a comprehensive set of security measures including monitoring, travel restrictions and continued information sharing.
