The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the national security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board recognized the detainee presents some level of threat given his history, but in light of factors and conditions of transfer identified below, the Board found that threat can be adequately mitigated. The Board considered the detainee's low-level role in LIFG and lack of leadership in the Taliban or Al Qaeda. The Board also considered the lack of information indicating that the detainee harbors extremist plans or anti-American sentiments.

The PRB recommends the following conditions that relate to the detainee's transfer: Resettlement to a third country with strong rehabilitation capabilities and reintegration support and implementation of a comprehensive set of security assurances including monitoring and travel restrictions.
