The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered that, despite some minimization regarding his prior associations, the detainee showed a relatively high level of candor regarding his reasons for traveling to Afghanistan and his activities while there. The Board also noted that the detainee took personal responsibility for his actions and understands the impact of those actions. Furthermore, the Board considered that the detainee has taken extensive efforts to improve himself in detention through classes and keeping up with his medical knowledge, has been highly compliant with the guard staff, has not committed any significant disciplinary infractions, and has never expressed anti-American sentiment or made comments supporting extremism. Finally, the Board noted that the detainee has credible plans for the future, has shown an ability to achieve those plans, and had extensive letters of support to include offers to assist with his integration in a new country upon transfer.

The PRB recommends that the detainee be transferred, with appropriate security assurances as determined by the Special Envoys, to a country outside of Yemen, consistent with the detainee's stated desire.
