The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board considered the detainee's low level of training and lack of leadership position in Al Qaeda or the Taliban, the detainee's candor regarding his activities in Afghanistan and with Al Qaeda, and the detainee's efforts to improve himself while in detention, to include taking numerous courses at Guantanamo. In addition, the ability and willingness of the detainee's family to support him in the event of transfer, the detainee's credible plan for supporting himself in the event of transfer, and significant improvement in the detainee's compliance since his last hearing in 2016.

The PRB recommends the following condition that relate to the detainee's transfer: robust security assurances to include monitoring, travel restrictions and integration support, as agreed to by relevant USG departments and agencies.
