FACTORS WHICH CONTRIBUTED TO THE CONSENSUS DETERMINATION (*attach additional sheets if needed*)

- The detainee was a trusted member al Qaeda who worked directly for senior members of al Qaeda, including Osama bin Laden, serving as a translator, courier, facilitator, and operative. The detainee had advanced knowledge of many al Qaeda attacks, to probably include 9/11, and progressed to financing, planning, and participating in attacks in Afghanistan against U.S. and Coalition targets.
- The detainee's consistent and long-standing expressions of support for violence against the United States and Coalition Forces.
- The detainee's failure to participate in the Periodic Review Board process prevented the Board from assessing whether he has had any change in either his mindset or current level of threat.
- The Board encourages the detainee to participate in the Periodic Review Board process so that the Board may consider whether he has had any change in his mindset.

The PRB recommends the following conditions that relate to the detainee's transfer
